Scholarship Cords & Tassels

United Way of Central Georgia is pleased to present a commemorative 2024 Golden Eagle Scholarship Cord to each of our outstanding nominees this year.

Throughout history, cords and tassels have been a marker of honor and distinction with royalty, military, and even architecture. The ornamental cord is an item made up of silk yarns braided together and ending with a tassel that ties the yarns of the cord's loose ends together. Cords with tassels have been in use dating back to the 14th century to represent levels of learning and are similar to the type of Academic Regalia that is still in use in modern times.

Today, one of the most common uses of the braided cord S tassel is in a commencement ceremony and saved as a commemorative keepsake. This distinction of honor has become one of the most desired pieces of graduation attire. An honor cord S tassel most often represents membership of a smaller group within a class to differentiate the accomplished graduate in other areas of academic life known as honor societies in various areas of study and group affiliations. Different clubs, scholarships, and organizations use cords to distinguish their members.

Honor cords also vary in color and meaning. The Golden Eagle colors are gold and navy blue. The color gold represents achievement, quality, honor, and knowledge and the color navy blue stands for success, confidence, purpose, and integrity. Congratulations to all of our 2024 Golden Eagle nominees!




